Requirements for a class:

Venue: A facility that allows for moving and shooting within the bays. I require 2 bays, one for drills and one for a stage.

I would like to have access to a full range of USPSA match props.

Class size: For a **Practical Shooting Fundamentals** class, I cap the class at 12 students. I only accept people who have been in the sport long enough to be classified (unless they get prior approval from me).

For a **Practical Shooting Skills and Drills** class I cap the students at 8. The drills in these classes are more complicated and the round count is higher. Generally, I want all the students in this class to be a solid B class or higher, and too have taken the **Practical Shooting Fundamentals** class.

Cost: The per student fee depends on the number of students and travel time and expenses. Generally it cost \$350 per student for a **Practical Shooting Fundamentals** class. The **Practical Shooting Skills and Drills** class generally cost \$500 a student. The host will be provided with a free slot provided the required student head count is met.

My travel expenses are built into the tuition cost and are not the responsibility of the class host.

I do require a deposit of 1/2 the class tuition before the class and the remainder will be paid after the class is completed.
